The Owyhee Cattleman's Heritage Foundation was formed as a 501(c)(3) organization to promote awareness, appreciation, and preservation of the Western lifestyle through education and, if necessary, legal action. The objective of the organization is to be proactive rather than reactive in the decision making process. The Foundation uses its resources to safeguard the public lands while at the same time promoting and protecting the inherent appurtenant rights through full utilization of the land.

The Owyhee Cattleman's Heritage Foundation has contributed financially in many different ways to meet its mission. These include the following: 1) hiring a qualified range management specialist to gather accurate, scientifically based data of the range lands to document their condition and trends; 2) developing a brochure and conducting fund raising to share its interest in promoting multiple use of the rangelands; 3) assisting in the documentation of the historical evidence of the sage grouse population in this territory; 4) providing resources to parties in litigation involving issues of broad public interest and impact to the area including water rights and utilization of public lands; 5) providing educational opportunities by assisting with scholarships and help defray travel costs to agricultural related events for future generations to encourage, enlighten, and stir appreciation of the western lifestyle and values of our heritage.
